NETWORK HOUSING FIRST ITALIA

The 1st march 2014 **fio.PSD** launched the National Programme for Implementing Housing First in Italy (training, supervision, and 24 months impact evaluation). Social services working with homeless people responded to this call. They started to experiment housing first approach based on rapid access to home for chronical homeless people.

Today, **54 organizations** (municipalities, social enterprises, caritas, and foundations) are members of Network Housing First Italia (NHFI) and **550 long-term homeless people** and people with severe housing exclusion problems are housed.
