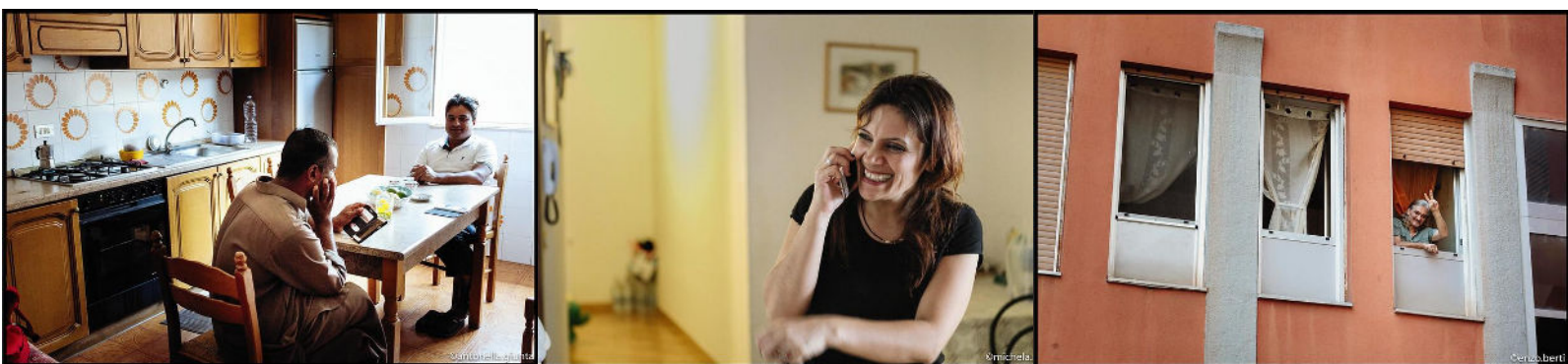

HOUSING FIRST PROJECT MAP*

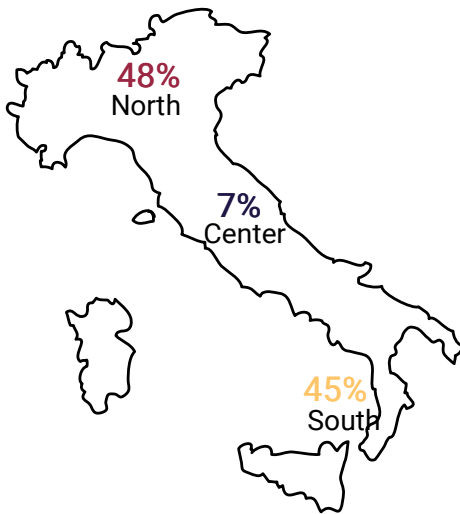
Distribution of beneficiaries by projects

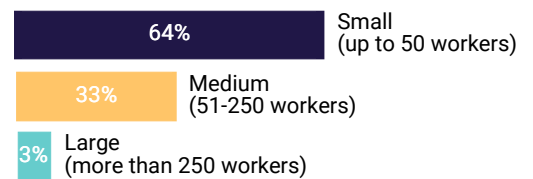

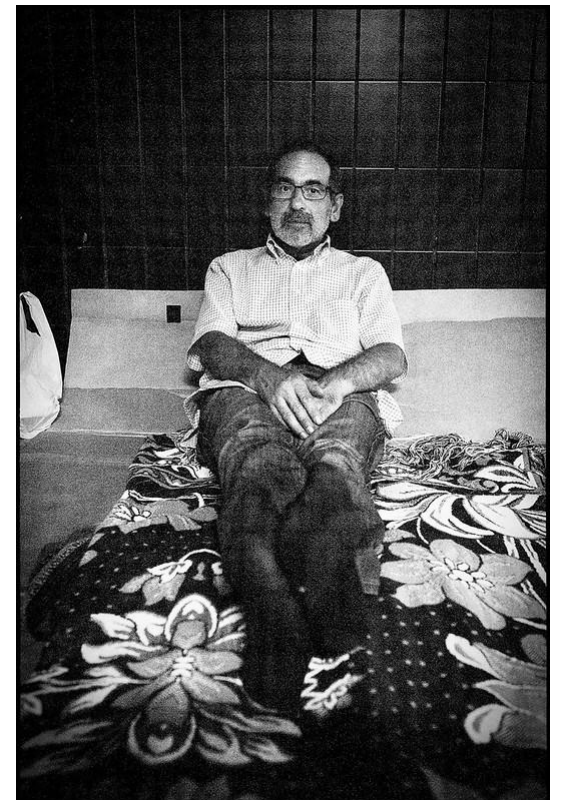
67% of the providers declare that they carry out other housing projects (apartment group, co-housing, shared apartments for women only or men only, etc...)

30% are between 45 and 55 years old

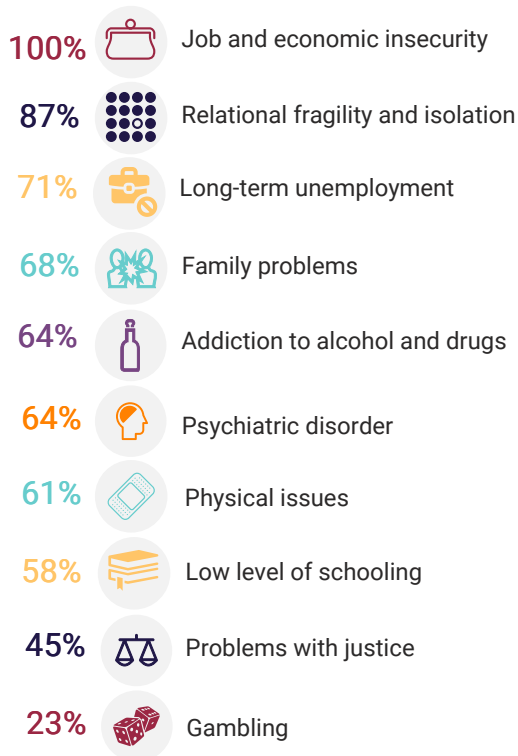
1 out 3 is a single adult

BENEFICIARIES

Beneficiaries involved in Housing First projects are people with high assistance needs, with chronic and repeated homeless life experiences (Goering and Tsemberis, 2014).

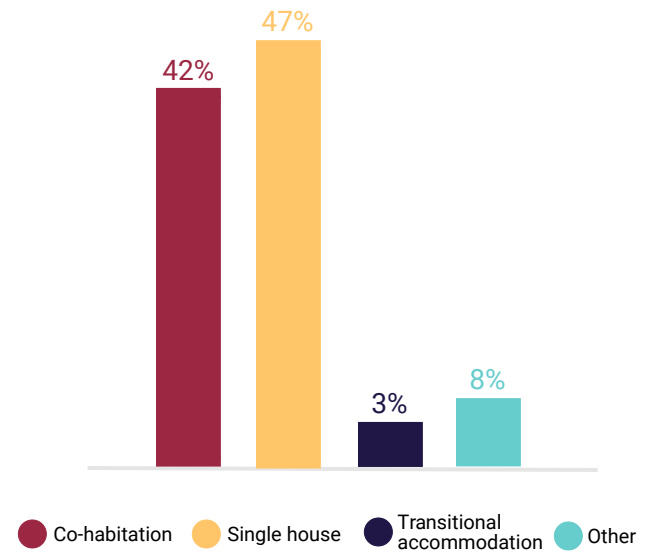

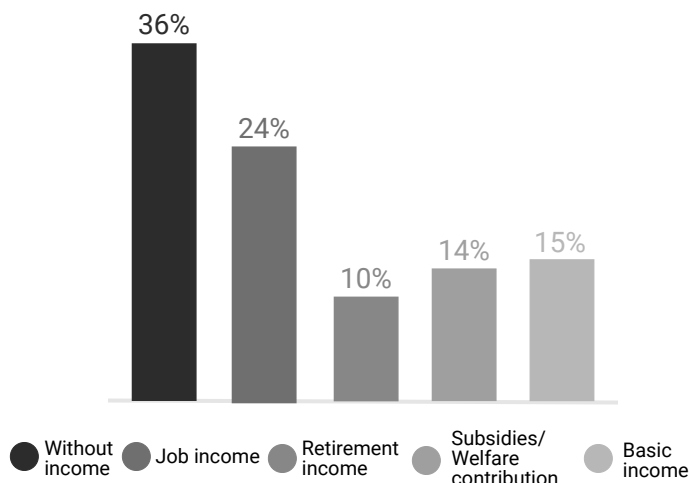

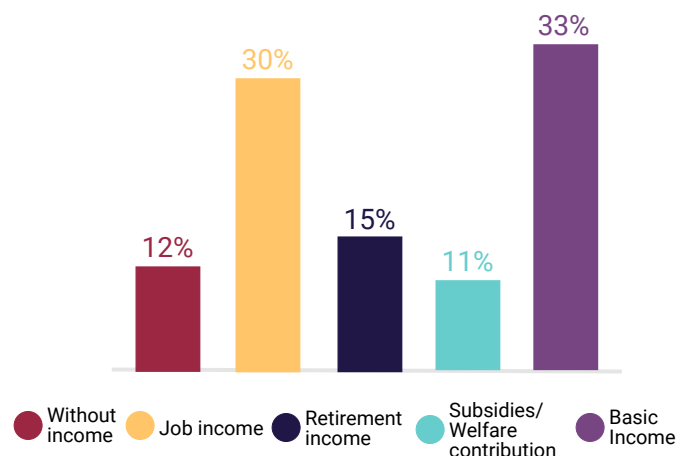
